RULES & REGULATIONS

- NAME** 1. The name of the Society shall be the Oxford and Cambridge Sailing Society.
- OBJECTS** 2. The objects of the Society are the encouragement of yacht sailing and racing and, in particular, team racing.
- FLAG** 3. The Flag of the Society shall be a dark blue flag bearing a lion passant gardant or with a paw resting on a book gules charged with a cross or.
- MEMBERSHIP** 4. Election of all candidates for membership shall be by the Committee.
Every candidate shall be proposed and seconded by members of the Society, to both of whom the candidate shall be personally known. Both the proposer and seconder shall write letters to the Secretary of the Society in support of the candidate.
Membership shall be confined to present or past members of the Oxford University Yacht

Club or of the Cambridge University Cruising Club who are no longer in residence as undergraduates.

5. The membership shall be limited to such a number as the Society shall in General Meeting each year decide; but the maximum number shall not in any one year be increased by more than six.

OFFICERS

6. The Officers of the Society shall consist of a President, Honorary Secretary, Honorary Treasurer and Honorary Deputy Secretary.

COMMITTEE

7. The Committee shall consist of the Officers and two other members. At all meetings three shall form a quorum. When present; the President shall be Chairman, but in his absence a Chairman shall be elected before any business is transacted. At any Meeting, in the event of equal voting, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.

**GENERAL
MEETING**

8. It shall be the duty of the Committee to manage the affairs of the Society, subject to the approval of the Society at its General Meeting.

9. The Officers and Committee shall be elected for one year only by a simple majority of the votes of members present at the General Meeting to be held during February in each year.

At a General Meeting, when present, the President shall be Chairman, but in his absence a Chairman shall be elected before any business is transacted.

**ALTERATION
TO RULES**

10. The rules of the Society shall not be altered except by a two-thirds majority of members present at the Annual General Meeting or at an Extraordinary General Meeting called for the purpose.

At such Meeting not less than one-third of the members of the Society shall form a quorum.

Two weeks' notice shall be given to all members of any proposed change in the rules.

**HONORARY
MEMBERSHIP**

11. The Committee shall have power to elect any person as an honorary member of the Society for such period not exceeding one year as they may think fit.

SUBSCRIPTION

12. The Subscription shall be One Guinea per annum, payable to the Honorary Treasurer on the 1st January in each year.

13. The Honorary Treasurer shall produce, at the Annual General Meeting, correct accounts for the past year, ending the 31st of December in the preceding year.

14. The Society in General Meeting shall have power to raise the subscription for all members at its discretion.

15. The Committee has power at any time to expel any member.

As the result of experience gained during the past seasons, the most satisfactory method of scoring points in team races is as follows :—

One point for each boat finishing and one point for each boat beaten, the winner to receive an additional quarter of a point, *i.e.* for six boats, the winner receives $6\frac{1}{4}$ points, and the others 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, in order of finishing. In races where there are less than three boats a side the additional quarter point should not apply.
